

## MiPCT All-Payer Patient List

### July 2013 Changes to Sort Order and File Layout

Last Updated: **June 6, 2013**

#### Summary

After receiving and working with the **MiPCT All-Payer Patient List** on a monthly basis since December 2012, MiPCT Clinical Leadership identified changes which will make the list easier for MiPCT Care Managers to use. These changes will be implemented with the **July 2013** All Payer Patient List.

The changes include:

1. **Sorting the patient records** in a specific order which will help to more quickly identify patients of interest for care management services.
2. **Changing the file layout** to move certain fields (columns) to the beginning of the record layout. These fields are of special interest when reviewing a patient’s information to determine the appropriate care management actions for that patient. The current file layout contains many fields and it can be difficult to find and review the relevant information.

This document summarizes the **Sort Order** and **File Layout** changes.

#### Sort Order Changes

The patient records will be sorted in the file as follows:

Sort Sequence	Sort Field	Sort Order									
1.	<b>Payer</b>	Alphabetical									
2.	<b>High Deductible Flag</b>	Members enrolled in the high deductible plans would be sorted to the bottom of the list									
3.	<b>Concurrent Risk Group</b>	Highest Risk to Lowest Risk. The order would be: <b>Very High</b> <b>High</b> <b>Medium</b> <b>Low</b> <b>Very Low</b> <b>Not Available</b>									
4.	<b>Chronic Condition Fields</b>	Sort by the 9 Chronic Condition flag fields, in the following order: <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td style="width: 33%;">1. Diabetes</td> <td style="width: 33%;">4. COPD</td> <td style="width: 33%;">7. ADHD</td> </tr> <tr> <td>2. Asthma</td> <td>5. HTN</td> <td>8. CAD</td> </tr> <tr> <td>3. CHF</td> <td>6. ## July 2013 Changes to All Payer Patient List

### File Layout Changes

Because there are so many fields in this file, it is difficult to find and see all the fields of interest at once, and even more difficult to print them on one sheet of paper (for situations where hardcopy is useful).

Therefore, the following fields will appear at the beginning of the record layout:

1. **Demographic fields:** Payer Specific Member ID, Member First Name, Member Last Name, Member Date of Birth, Age, Gender
2. **Attribution fields:** Attributed Physician NPI, Attributed Physician First Name, Attributed Physician Last Name, Attributed Practice Unit ID, Attributed Practice Unit Name
3. **Risk fields:** Concurrent Risk Score, Concurrent Risk Group, Prospective Risk Score
4. **Cost:** Standard Cost
5. **Utilization fields:** # of Inpatient Visits, # of ED visits, # of Readmissions, # of visits to any PCP, Most recent PCP visit date, # of Chronic Conditions, # of maintenance drug prescriptions
6. **Chronic Condition flags:** Diabetes, Asthma, CHF, COPD, HTN, Obesity, ADHD, CAD, CKD

Using this field order, the resulting file record layout will be:
