## SIM PCMH Dashboard Release 2.0 Posted!

Michigan Data Collaborative (MDC) is excited to announce that release 2.0 of the SIM PCMH Dashboard is now available!

### Data

Release 2.0 includes the following Medicaid data:

- A 12-month measurement period with dates of service between June 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017
- Paid claims data through July 2017 (allowing for a two-month run-out period)
- Patients and provider attribution from the May 2017 PCMH Patient List and Provider Hierarchy File
- All measures are based on Medicaid eligibility, medical, and drug claims. In a future release, EMR/Clinical data will also be added.

### New Measures

Dashboard Release 2.0 contains the following new measures:

- Adolescent Well-Care Visits
- Childhood Immunization Status
- Chlamydia Screening in Women
- Immunization Status for Adolescents
- Lead Screening in Children
- Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life
- Well-Child Visits in the Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Years of Life

### Dashboard Updates

Dashboard Release 2.0 contains the following updates:

- There are two new pages in Release 2.0:
  - **Comparisons Page:** Use this page to compare quality measure and utilization rates against the rates for other POs, practices, and providers (based on your access permissions).
  - **Tile Page:** Use this page to view a snapshot of all quality and utilization measure rates for the report level you select.
- With Release 2.0, you can now view data at the provider level. The “My Providers” option is available from the Select Report Level dropdown on each page.
- HEDIS benchmarks have been removed from the Dashboard for Release 2.0. MDC is currently exploring options to display them for the expanding set of measures and will include them in a future release

## 1st Quarter 2017 Aggregated Difference Reports Posted

Today, MDC posted the **1st Quarter 2017 Aggregated Difference Reports** on the SIM PCMH Dashboard.

These one-time reports provide the difference between the original 1Q17 beneficiary counts and the revised counts that were provided after refinements were made to the attribution process. The purpose of this report is to help your organization reconcile the upcoming third quarter payments, which will include adjustments based on the first quarter differences.

### PCMH Difference Report Details

These reports are similar to the Aggregated Patient Reports you have been receiving quarterly, but include the following additional fields:

- **Q1 Original Total:** Contains the total beneficiaries from the original Q1 patient list
- **Q1 Revised Total:** Contains the total beneficiaries from the revised Q1 patient list
- **Diff:** Contains the difference between the original and revised (Q1 Revised – Q1 Original)

### PCMH Aggregated Report Details

## MDC Launches New Dashboard Access Method

MDC is excited to launch a new method to access the SIM PCMH Dashboard.

### Background

Michigan Data Collaborative (MDC) provides robust security measures to ensure secure access to your organization's SIM PCMH Initiative data and reports. In the past, this meant using the Michigan Medicine VPN (virtual private network). This spring, Michigan Medicine released a new secure access method, which we have tested extensively with help from several PO and practice beta testers. Through our testing, we concluded that this method is much more streamlined and easier to use.

### How it Works

This new method uses a [Citrix Receiver](#) (software you download on your computer) combined with [Duo two-factor authentication](#) to securely connect to a Michigan Medicine website called Virtual Places. From the Virtual Places website, you can access the SIM PCMH Dashboard.

### How to Get It

The first step is to ensure that you have your [Duo two-factor authentication](#) set up. (Duo was also required with the VPN access method, so most users will already have it set up.)

The second step is to read through and follow the instructions in the [Accessing the SIM PCMH Dashboard guide](#) on the [MDC Website](#).
