Introduction

The Michigan Data Collaborative (MDC) is a nonprofit healthcare data organization at Michigan Medicine. MDC supports the Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan (BCBSM) Physician Group Incentive Program (PGIP) Value Partnerships mission by producing the PGIP Quarterly Dashboard. The PGIP Quarterly Dashboard is a population health dashboard designed to empower you with tools for quality improvement and population health management. The dashboard provides easy to access, filterable reports for BCBSM PGIP participants.

PGIP Data & Dashboard

The PGIP Quarterly Dashboard uses the PGIP Dataset provided on a quarterly basis by BCBSM. The dashboard is designed to provide accurate and at-a-glance information about specific PGIP initiatives. Measures are searchable by PO, Sub-PO, Practice Unit, and Practitioner.

This User Guide provides step-by-step instructions on how to use the PGIP Quarterly Dashboard filters, access additional information via the Information icon 1 and export data.

Note: The data shown in all screenshots is either aggregate summary data or artificial data that is randomly generated for demonstration purposes only.

Before You Begin

- The PGIP dashboard is compatible with modern browsers such as Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari, and Microsoft Edge. Access to the PGIP dashboard is secured based on user credentials.
- Note: If you do not have an account, email <u>MDC-Accounts@med.umich.edu</u> to request access to the PGIP dashboard. Be sure to include your PO in this request.

Access and Setup Guide

The <u>Access and Setup Guide</u> provides detailed information about the steps that you must complete to access the PGIP dashboard, including setting up a University of Michigan (U-M) sponsored user account and Duo two-factor authentication.

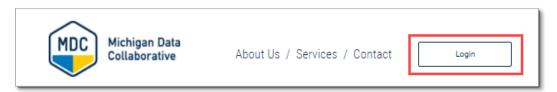

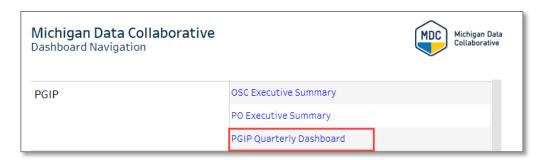
Logging in to the PGIP Quarterly Dashboard

Steps to access the PGIP dashboard:

1. Using your web browser, go to <u>michigandatacollaborative.org.</u> Select the **Login** button in the top navigation bar, as shown below.



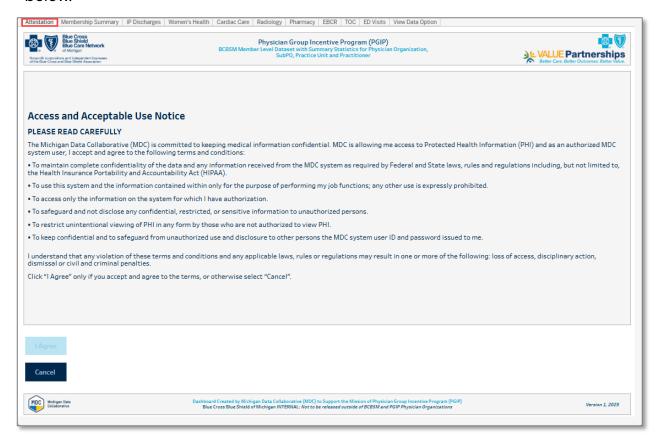
- 2. If you are not already logged in to the University of Michigan, you will be redirected to the U-M Weblogin page and prompted to enter the following information:
 - Username/uniqname. Type in your U-M uniqname.
 - Password. Type in your U-M Level-1 password.
- 3. Click Login.
- 4. Next, you will be required to complete Duo Two-Factor Authentication. To get help installing the Duo app or using two-factor authentication, see the <u>Access and Setup Guide</u>.
- 5. **Approve** the Duo request on your device *OR* approve two-factor authentication using the phone call method.
- 6. Next, the MDC Dashboard Navigation page will open. After you select **PGIP Quarterly Dashboard**, you will be directed to the PGIP dashboard.

Attestation Page

- 1. On the Attestation page, users must attest that they will use the patient information appropriately and maintain confidentiality of all data. Scroll down, review the content, and if acceptable, click **I Agree**.
- 2. Next, you will be redirected to the Home page/Membership Summary tab, as shown below.



Home Page Navigation and Features

The Home page is also the Membership Summary page or tab and has the following features:

- 1. **Navigation Tabs**. There are 10 navigation tabs across the top.
 - a. Membership Summary
 - b. IP (Inpatient) Discharges
 - c. Women's Health
 - d. Cardiac Care
 - e. Radiology
 - f. GDR (Generic Dispensing Rate)/Pharmacy
 - g. EBCR (Evidence-Based Clinical Resources)
 - h. TOC (Transition of Care)
 - i. ED (Emergency Department) Visits
 - j. View Data Option (functions the same as the View Data Option button)



- 2. **Reporting Period.** Date range of the dashboard data.
- 3. Physician Organization. Name of the selected or default Physician Organization.
- 4. **Information icon**. Hover your mouse over the Information icon **(1)** for helpful details and context about the dashboard data and features.



- 5. **Filters**. Select from the filters across the top of each page to customize the data by practitioner type, organization, subPO, practice unit, practitioner, and Report End Date.
 - a. Practitioner Type. This filter operates independently of other filters in the panel. Select from the following options:
 - (All). Default selection
 - o APP. Advanced Practice Provider
 - o MD/DO. Medical Doctor/Doctor of Osteopathy
 - b. Physician Organization. The name of the user's PO displays automatically.
 - c. SubPO.
 - d. Practice Unit.
 - e. Practitioner.
 - f. Report End Date. Defaults to the most recent report date.
 - g. Exception: Ensure that the Report End Date is explicitly selected within the EBCR initiative, as selections in other initiatives do not carry over since this is an annual report.



- By default, the filters are set to PO-level aggregations.
- The dashboard will automatically update to reflect your filter selections.
- The hierarchy you select will be reflected in your results.
- Results are limited to Practitioners enrolled in the PGIP program.

- 6. **Initiative** buttons. Click an initiative button to view and download data tables for that initiative
 - a. IP (Inpatient) Discharges
 - b. Women's Health
 - c. Cardiac Care
 - d. Radiology
 - e. GDR (Generic Dispensing Rate)/Pharmacy
 - f. EBCR (Evidence-Based Clinical Resources)
 - g. TOC (Transition of Care)
 - h. ED (Emergency Department) Visits

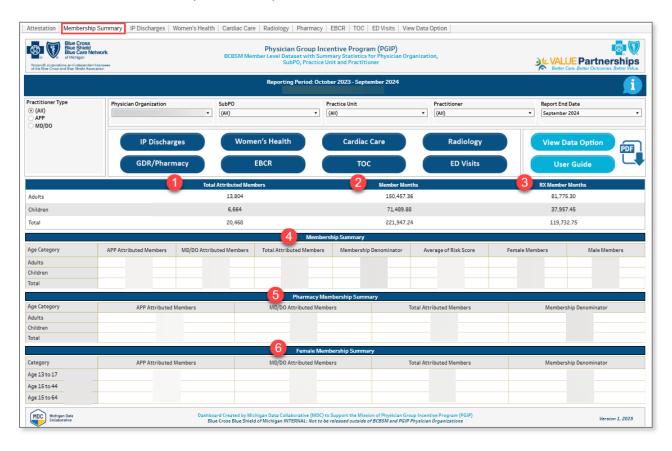
- 7. Select from these options to view and download data and documentation.
 - a. View Data Option button (functions like the View Data Option tab).
 - b. User Guide button. Links to this document.
 - c. **Download PDF** icon. Click on the **Download PDF** icon to download a PDF of the current view or the entire workbook.

PGIP Initiatives

What is a PGIP Initiative? A PGIP Initiative is a specific program or area of focus under the Physician Group Incentive Program (PGIP). This program, typically run by healthcare organizations or insurers, aims to improve healthcare quality, patient outcomes, and cost-effectiveness by encouraging physician groups to implement targeted interventions and best practices.

The Home page/Membership Summary tab includes the following PGIP Initiative buttons:

- 1. IP (Inpatient) Discharges
- 2. Women's Health
- 3. Cardiac Care
- 4. Radiology
- 5. GDR (Generic Dispensing Rate)/Pharmacy
- 6. EBCR (Evidence-Based Clinical Resources)
- 7. TOC (Transition of Care)
- 8. ED (Emergency Department) Visits



Accessing Initiative Results for Your Organization

To access the data for a specific initiative, follow these steps:

- 1. Starting from the **Home** page/**Membership Summary** tab, select either an initiative tab along the top or a button and you will be redirected to that initiative page.
- 2. In the filters panel, select the **Practitioner Type**: All, APP, MD/DO.
 - Note: This filter operates independently of other filters in the panel.

Select the organization level filter(s): Physician Organization (defaults to the user's PO, only shows POs the user has access to), SubPO, Practice Unit, Practitioner.

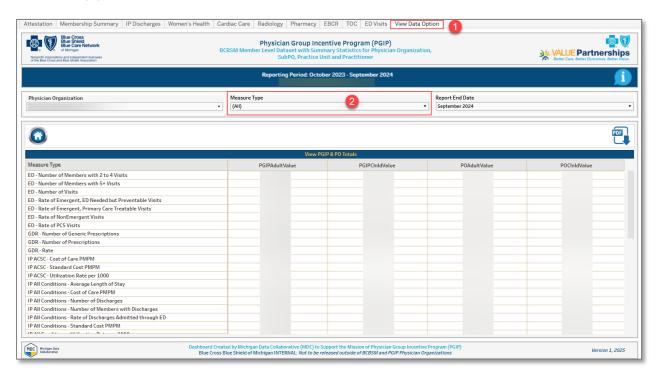
3. Select the Report End Date.



View Data Options

The View Data Options **tab**, and **View Data Options** button on the Home page allow you to access summary level data for each of the initiatives.

- 1. From the Home page, click the **View Data Options** tab or button.
- 2. When the PGIP and PO Totals page opens, the Measure Type filter defaults to All. Select a **Measure Type** option from the drop-down list to limit the display to one of the following options:
 - (All). Default selection.
 - ED Visits
 - GDR
 - IP
 - Membership
 - Radiology
 - TOC



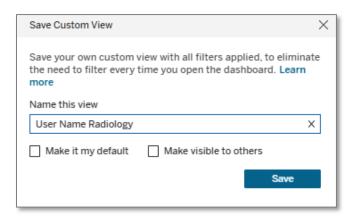
Custom Views

The PGIP Quarterly Dashboard has a feature that allows users to select their desired filters and save them in Custom Views for later use.

1. Click **Save Custom View** in the bottom toolbar.



- 2. In the **Save Custom View** pop-up window, enter the name of your Custom View in the **Name this view** field.
 - a. Select **Make it my default** if you'd like this view to be what you see each time you return to the dashboard.
 - b. Select Make visible to others if you'd like to share the view with others in your PO.
 - c. Or you can opt out of both options by making no selection.
 - d. Click Save to save your Custom View.
 - e. Click **View: [View Name]** on the bottom toolbar to select and manage your custom view(s).



Dashboard Subscriptions

This feature allows you to sign up to receive a PDF of the dashboard in your inbox at specified intervals.

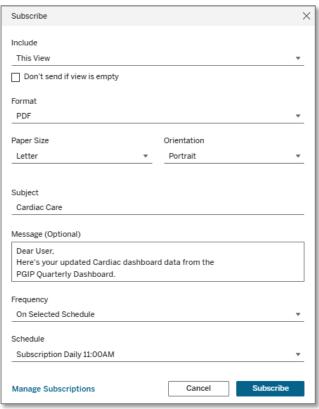
Note: Before setting up a Subscription, you MUST create a Custom View to override the Attestation step. For more information, go to <u>Custom Views</u>.

1. Click **Subscriptions** in the bottom toolbar.



2. Complete the fields in the **Subscribe** window to Indicate which dashboard views you would like emailed to you:

- Include: This View or Entire Workbook.
- Format: Image, PDF, or Image and PDF.
- Paper Size: Letter, Legal, etc.
- Orientation: Portrait or Landscape.
- Subject: defaults to name of current initiative displayed.
- Message (optional): Type in a custom message.
- Frequency: On Selected Schedule or When Data Refreshes.
- Schedule: Daily, Monthly, etc.
- Click Subscribe to submit.
- Select Manage Subscriptions if you wish to (i) unsubscribe, (ii) change your subscription after you've submitted it, or (iii) view all your subscriptions. Select from the following settings:
 - Change Frequency
 - Change Subject
 - Change Empty View Mode
 - Change Format
 - Unsubscribe



Helpful Tips

Returning to the Home Page from Other Dashboard Pages

You can easily navigate back to the Home page from any initiative-specific page (e.g., ED Visits, TOC, Radiology). The Home page icon allows seamless navigation across different dashboard pages/tabs.

Tooltips

Hover your mouse over any data points or sections to activate tooltip pop-ups with detailed information, as shown below.



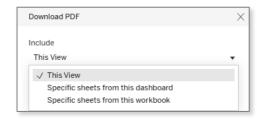
How to Download PDFs

The **Download PDF** button in the top-right corner of the dashboard allows you to export a PDF of the current dashboard page or the entire dashboard, one worksheet at a time.

a. Click the **Download PDF** button and select only the *default option: This View.*

Include > This View (default option).
Exports the current page view.

Note: Avoid selecting Specific sheets
from this dashboard as this is used
internally for dashboard development.
Feel free to select Specific Sheets from
this Workbook to download the entire
dashboard, one worksheet at a time.



- b. Formatting the PDF. Choose from the following options:
 - Scaling (Automatic or %). Adjust scaling to fit the content.
 - Page Size (Letter [default], Legal, etc.). Select page size from the dropdown list.
 - Orientation (Portrait or Landscape).
 - Note: The landscape option may be better suited for pages such as the Inpatient initiative with larger data tables.
- c. After configuring the settings, click **Download** and save the PDF to your computer.
